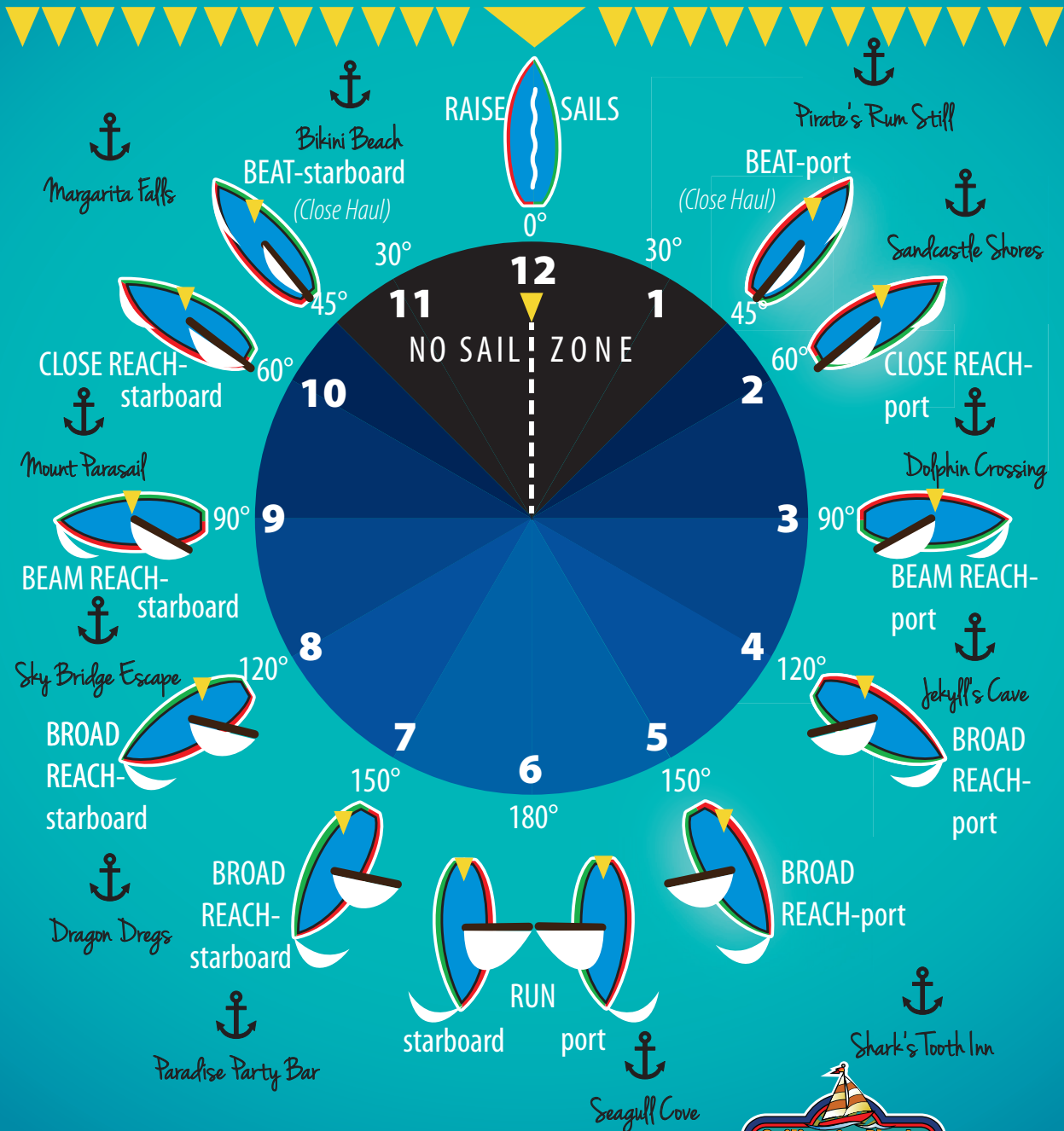

Three Steps to Sailing

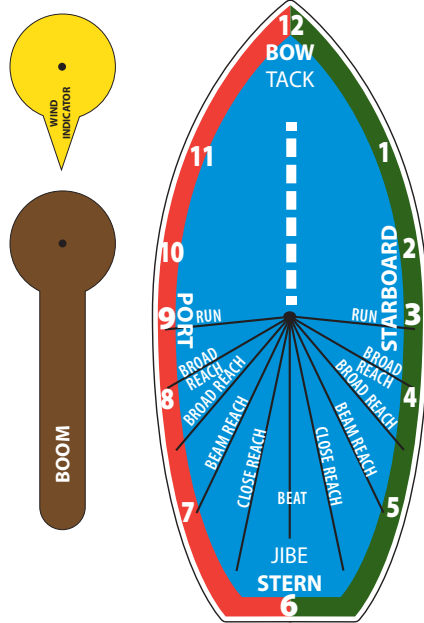
- World = #1 Wind
- Class = #2 Course
- Sailor = #3 Sail Set

Sail Set Guidelines

- A. Wind over front of boat, set sails close in.
- B. Wind over side of boat, set sails halfway out.
- C. Wind over back of boat, set sails all the way out.

ASSEMBLY OF THE SIMULATOR

1. Paste the simulator chart on a piece of cardboard.
2. Paste the boat, the boom and the wind indicator on a piece of cardboard and cut them out.
3. Attach the boat, the boom, and the wind indicator to the chart with a brass-plated two-prong fastener
being careful to center it in the chart.

HOW TO USE THE SIMULATOR

1. Line up the wind indicator with the large yellow wind arrow.
2. Turn the boat to the direction you want to go.
3. Set the mainsail by positioning the boom on the lines in the back of the boat
4. The small boat will show you where the wind is hitting the boat and the sail set.
5. The large boat should mirror the sail sets on the small boat.
6. Repeat the process until you understand the points of sail.

Each time you change the course of the boat, you will line up the wind indicator with the large wind arrow. Then you will move the boom to the correct position in the back (aft) of the boat.
